Pennsylvania's Request for an Extension of the CWDP and Renegotiation of the Capped Title IV-E Allocation

OCYF continues to work with ACF to reach a final determination regarding the renegotiation of capped allocations.

In the interim, PA has been granted another short-term waiver extension, to December 31, 2018. During this interim period, all aspects of the previously approved Terms & Conditions remain in effect, with the exception of Philadelphia's participation.

It is expected that the project will be extended for another year through September 30, 2019 upon conclusion of this short-term period. OCYF will continue to provide any additional supporting documentation to support the renegotiation of capped allocations.
