Evaluation Update from the CWRC

Data collection for the EBP sub-study and Family Engagement Study continues. Additionally, the Evaluation Team remains in contact with counties regarding completion of SPANS and Family Engagement Observations for the current fiscal year. We appreciate all efforts to make these evaluation activities possible!

Last month the Evaluation Team distributed the annual Facilitator Survey to counties. This survey is distributed to all county and provider staff that participate in the facilitation of Family Engagement meetings. The survey aims to help the Evaluation Team learn about the Family Engagement models used throughout the life of the CWDP. This round of the Facilitator Survey remains open until September 20th. The Evaluation Team recently distributed updated Flash Reports with updated CANS, FAST and EBPAS data. Flash Talks were held on these topics in 2016 and early 2017.
