

ACTION PLAN

Identify a family to whom you would like to offer the Family Group Decision Making (FGDM) process. In considering a family, you may recall that there are six questions on which to reflect (*i.e.*, Stacking for Success). In addition to a final question asking you the concrete steps you will take to initiate the FGDM process with the family, listed below are the six Stacking for Success questions. As you consider a family for the FGDM process, answer the following questions.

1. Are you willing to help the family with the follow-up?
2. Are you willing to attend the meeting and consider the family plan?
3. Can the people invited accomplish the purpose?
4. Is the purpose clear and understandable? Does it motivate everyone to attend?
5. Is the family voluntarily participating and have they agreed to participate in the Family Group Decision Making process?
6. Do you have hope for the family? Do you believe the family has the ability to come together and be successful in creating a family plan?
7. What steps will you now take to initiate the process with this family?
