Our revision and redesign of Charting the Course.

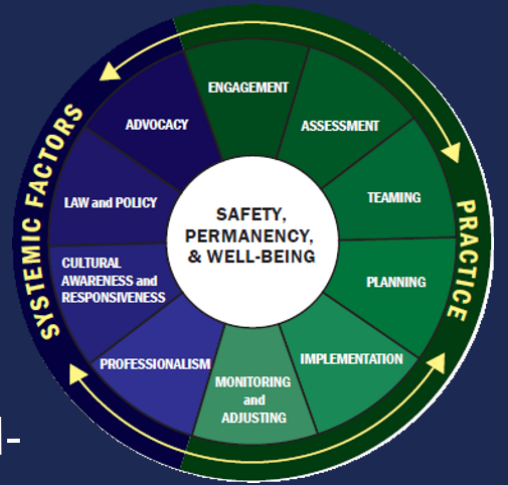
Some of the new things you will see are:

Partners: We take the lead in training.

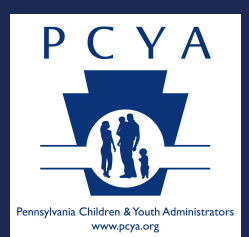
Counties take the lead in ensuring training transfers to practice.
