

Curriculum Materials: Return to In-Person 2022

Instructor Update

We have made the decision to limit printed materials for curricula as we transition back to in-person sessions. This decision is part of an effort to reduce the amount of printed materials that may not be used by participants. We welcome your feedback about this change and will monitor and adjust based on your provided feedback.

Foundations Courses:

For all in-person Foundations module handouts, we've decided to only print 1 copy per participant for the handouts that are job aid-type handouts (those that are useful for staff to take with them and reference after training). The other handouts, we are only printing 1 copy of each, for you to reference if needed during the training day, or in the event someone requests a paper copy for an accommodation.

Additionally, we are communicating in advance to all counties and to individual participants that they must bring a fully charged laptop or tablet to all in-person training days. This was also a request of all Foundations participants prior to the pandemic.

For other handouts that you only receive 1 copy of, if you would like all participants to see or use these during the training session, you can share them on the overhead projector.

For all in-person sessions, instructors, participants, and SCs will receive an email from Bridge with the information about the in-person training session, pre-requisites, and other training information.

Advanced Level Courses:

For advanced level courses we are also reducing the amount of materials we are printing. We have reviewed all advanced level courses and noted which materials are required to be printed for the courses. These materials will be included in the training box. Other materials we are asking participants to access electronically through the curriculum website.

We are communicating in advance to all counties and to individual participants that they must bring an electronic device to the training and that phones are not sufficient for training purposes. For all in-person sessions, instructors and participants will receive an email from Bridge with the information about the in-person training session, pre-work (when applicable), and link to the curriculum materials on the website. Participants may print materials before coming to the training if that is their preference, but this is not required.

Foundations of Supervision:

Foundations of Supervision will run remotely until we are able to conduct an in-person pilot.
