

# Learning Objective and Agenda

## Learning Objective:

Following this session, participants will be able to:

- Promote and improve the counties' use of the Family Finding Model.

**Process:** This TOL session will use a facilitator to model a positive method of reviewing cases from the perspective of the Family Finding Model, much as the supervisors would use when conducting case reviews with the casework staff.

## Agenda:

- Case review (allow 1 hour per case):
  1. A brief overview of the case: based upon pre-work;
  2. Crosswalk work accomplished to steps in the Family Finding model;
  3. Review how successes were accomplished;
  4. Review the barriers that were faced in accomplishing the successes and how those barriers were overcome;
  5. Consider the barriers that are currently being faced and how those barriers might be overcome; and
  6. Consider the work that has yet to be completed and identify next steps.
    - a. Anticipate the barriers to completion of future work and how those barriers might be overcome.
- Summary:
  - Summarize the work completed and any lessons learned.
  - Review with participants the successes they achieved.
  - Review with participants any changes they made on Family Finding plans and related efforts as they went through this process.
- After action review: Provide feedback to the facilitator as to:
  - What worked well for you during this workshop;
  - What could be done better;
  - How confident are you in your knowledge and skills surrounding the Family Finding process; and
  - What would help you increase your level of confidence?
