

# Appendix 1: True or False Quiz Answers

1. **True** – Children age 0 – 3 will watch or poke at other people’s bodies.
2. **False** – Children age 9 – 12 value privacy highly.
3. **True** – Children age 4 – 5 play games like “Doctor.”
4. **False** – Children age 6 – 8 prefer to socialize with their own gender almost exclusively and maintain a rigid separation between males and females.
5. **True** – Most adolescents age 18 and over understand their own sexual orientation, although they may still experiment.
6. **True** – Children age 4 – 5 (and as young as 0 – 3) experience erection or vaginal lubrication.
7. **False** – Children age 13 – 17 understand that they are sexual and understand the options and consequences of sexual expression.
8. **False** – Although it is common for 15-year-old boys to masturbate, it is concerning when an adolescent masturbates to the point of making his genitals raw.
9. **False** – One should become concerned if a child’s drawings depict genitals as the predominant feature.
10. **True** – It is concerning if a child engages in sexual behaviors with those who are much older or younger. Most school-aged children engage in sexual behavior with children within a year or so of their age. In general, the wider the age range between children engaging in sexual behaviors, the greater the concern.
11. **False** – Although children of the same age range might participate in games such as “Spin the Bottle,” it would be concerning that siblings of varied ages played “Spin the Bottle” with one another.
12. **False** – It is concerning if a child tries to manipulate children or adults into touching his/her genitals or causes physical harm to his/her own or other’s genitals.
