

# Follow-up in FGDM

## Monitoring

- The family and the referral source monitor the plan.
- The family plan should address who will assist in monitoring.
- Individuals should be identified to monitor the plan and the participants.
- Family should be educated on monitoring early in coordination.

## FGDM Follow-Up

- Many counties follow-up with surveys at 6 and 12 months after the meeting.

## Follow-Up Meetings

- Formal meeting to ensure the longevity of the plan.
- Follow-up meetings are strongly encouraged by the PA FGDM Leadership Team.
- Often scheduled at the meeting.
- Anybody present can request a follow-up meeting.
- Who will be contacted should be covered at the meeting.
- Family identifies what resources participate in the follow-up meeting.
- Follow-up meetings are frequently shorter than the original meeting.
- Discuss what is going well with the plan and what parts need modified.
